When the RCMP have to remove children from situations where they have witnessed violence or abuse, the child often has nothing but the clothes they are wearing. Caring Hearts provides the soft hand-stitched blankets that police officers carry with them to help calm scared and confused little ones.

Caring Hearts is a non-profit organization that began ten years ago with the intention of providing underprivileged kids with homemade clothing and comforts.

If you are lucky, you remember having a favorite blanket, toy, or sweater that was made with love by your mother or grandparent. In today's busy world, many people struggle just to keep their children safe and fed. Sometimes those special comforts and possessions get lost along the way.

We believe that every child deserves the warmth and comfort that comes from a handcrafted item made by caring hands.

Ten years ago, our founder – an avid knitter, wanted to know how she could get her extra homemade things to children in need. Today we provide handcrafted clothing, sweaters, blankets, mitts, toques, scarves, and baby layettes to service providers, transition houses, schools, and community groups all over the lower mainland.

Our 300+ volunteers knit, crochet, quilt and sew thousands of beautiful donations every year. The artistic beauty, and the detailed craftsmanship of these items surprise us every day. Their quality could easily match that of any high-end boutique.

Winter is coming, and we expect to give out in excess of 2000 toques, 900 scarves, and 1000 pairs of mitts and slippers to children in our elementary school programs alone. Every year we receive thanks and photographs from kids playing out in the snow. Some of these children show up at school without jackets, let alone mittens. Without our help, teachers would have to keep them inside, and they might never know the joy of building snowmen with their friends.

Caring Hearts provides the wool, fabric, and other materials that our volunteers craft into wonderful homemade gifts for children. We stock these materials, and the finished items, at our office in Surrey. Our organization is run entirely by volunteers.
