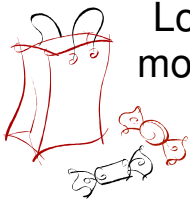
Once per season someone to take current photos of handmade items in the office to update the website pictures.

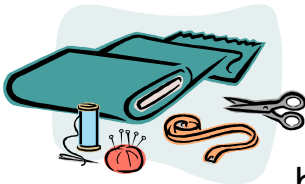
Membership committee
